- For groups of up to 12 passengers, must include a minimum of 2 staff
- Ramp and lift for wheelchair access (maximum 2 wheelchair users)
- Large open front deck
- Deep picture windows throughout
- Central heating
- Toilet
- Free hot and cold drinks provided
- A qualified skipper and crew member on every trip
- Secure parking at the boatyard

All trips are on the Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal, starting from and returning to Hatherton Marina, Queen's Road, Calf Heath, Cannock WV10 7DT. Trips usually start at 10:30am.

Summer evening trips also available on request.

Your responsibilities

Group staff must ensure that all passengers are safe and adequately supported at all times.

In some cases this may mean one to one support.





Routes

- 1. Trip to Coven and return. This can include a lunch stop at the Fox & Anchor pub, or order fish & chips on board or bring your own packed lunch.
- 2. Non-stop trip to Autherley Junction and return. Fish & chips can be ordered on board or bring your own packed lunch.
